#### **Somerset Chess Club**

What is chess, do you think? Those who play for fun or not at all dismiss it as a game. The ones who devote their lives to it for the most part insist that it's a science. It's neither. Bobby Fischer got underneath it like no one before and found at its center: art - From Searching for Bobby Fischer.

The 1993 film Searching for Bobby Fischer dramatizes the true story of prodigy Josh Waitzkin, but like a great chess game, teaches a different lesson than the surface story about the game itself. A lesson about parenthood. Watch it today with your kids, and you'll begin to understand why Chess is such a beloved art form around the world.

At Somerset, the Chess club has been growing in size and accomplishment every year, with the school team tying for first place on total points in last year's Chess Club starts on October 5th, and registrations are open now! Your child will join local coaches Tim and Brad after school, along with other Somerset kids in their range of ability, and enjoy a fun workout for their brain. And at a cost of less than \$10/hr (25 classes, 1.5 hr each), Chess Club is an incredible investment!

Here are just a few of the MANY benefits of playing Chess:

- It can raise your IQ.
- It helps prevent Alzheimer's.
- It exercises both sides of the brain.
- It increases your creativity.
- It improves your memory.
- It increases problem-solving skills.
- It improves reading skills.
- It improves concentration.
- It grows dendrites (the nervous system's antennas that pick up signals from other brain cells).
- It teaches planning and foresight (promotes development of the prefrontal cortex, the area of the brain responsible for planning, judgement, and selfcontrol).

If you've ever considered signing your child up for Chess Club, now is the time to do it! Chess is an excellent workout for the brain, stretching it in ways that enhance traditional academic learning. This is so important now as our kids are forced to be more independent in their learning and to self-motivate. Playing chess gives kids the confidence to make this leap, and also provides a social network outside the classroom. Kids can bond with other Somerset students and set up chess playdates!

Never played before? No problem! Coaches Brad and Tim are excellent at introducing kids to chess for the first time. They also teach Intermediate and Advanced level classes and are happy to do a quick assessment to know where to place your child.



## Update on Transition to Hybrid Learning

In our message to families last week we announced the developing plan of our return to Hybrid Learning, outlining the order in which we plan to welcome student groups back.

While some limited in-person learning is occurring, we will welcome student groups back as follows:

- 1. Pre-K 2nd grade for 5 days per week
- 2. 3<sup>rd</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> grade students for 2-3 days per week
- 3. Middle and high school ( $6^{th}$   $12^{th}$  grades) begin with 1 day per week
- 4. Middle and high school moving to 2-3 days per week

The transition will be gradual, more like turning a dial than flipping a switch. Once we see a consistent downward trend in infection rates, we will bring students back in gradual waves for in-person instruction. The plan is start with our younger students and move to our older students due to more limited social interaction at lower grades and ensuring that health and safety plans and protocols are systematically put in place.
