What is DARE?

It is a series of related classes that teach kids skills to avoid drugs, alcohol, gangs and violence. Started in 1983 in Los Angeles, it has been presented to 75% of our nation's school districts and in over 43 countries around the world. These police officer led series teach k-12th graders to resist peer pressure and to live productive, drug free, and violence free lives, while building positive relationships between students and police officers. D.A.R.E. opens lines of communication between law enforcement and youth as well as enhancing dialogue between students, parents and schools; communication is one key to a student's successful journey through middle and high school years and beyond. **Class topics will include** healthy decision making, facts about tobacco, marijuana, alcohol, friendship foundations, peer pressure, personal pressure, and ways to avoid risky situations. The class will include role-playing opportunities and group discussions. This program brings inquiry and discussion with parents home for parental interaction.
