Principal Elder Update:

- Somerset has approval for district sponsored funding for an additional GSA for this year
- $\bullet \hspace{0.4cm}$ This year's theme for the school is to speak up for yourself when

you see something that is unfair, speak out with pride

- Principal Elder went to all 30 classrooms to read the book "More than Peach" for this year's theme
 - We have kicked off birthday fun run which the goal is for kids to outrun the principal
 - Curriculum night was a success there was a repeat session offered for all parents
 - Fall classroom celebration will kick off soon where we want to be inclusive and affirming, we are a diverse community so there will be a Halloween plus to celebrate everyone
- The school does not promote or invite costumes during the celebrations
 - This year, we have 716 students the highest in the district due to Somerset hosts advance learning which draws from other schools
- o Still a small size classroom
- o 80 Staff members to ensure high quality support
- On-site school nurse for 4 out of 5 days now
- We have 8 GSA (general school assistants) and we are hoping to hire another
- There are numerous opportunities to support students such as volunteer in the office or library, and events because we try to foster a family experience.

Treasurer Update

- Emphasis on a Spring Auction because that is where the most of our funding will come from, last auction was 2 years ago and it was extremely successful
- o Discussions around alternatives to Auction
 - Silent Auction
 - Movie night for kids + silent auction
- Will we be profitable with the current economy? Current goal from auction is \$150k
 - Next month we will have a detailed review of the budget to be approved by BOD
 - Majority of our budget goes to funding of GSA and we need to continue to support GSA
- This year we will work on a grant with the National PTA, however grants have a lot of limitations, so TBD.
 - Due to the previous years of fundraising success, we still have a little residual funding, but we need to raise money for next year!

 - Kung Fu (6:30 to 7:30 PM on Mondays),
 - Drumming (2:45 to 3:45 PM on Wednesday),
 - Chinese: (7:45 AM to 8:45 AM Tuesday and Thursday (2 Levels,10-20 students for each level),
 - These new vendors need approval from the Board and President will send out a written proposal before next BOD meeting
 - Somerset Elementary Extracurricular Funding for STEM coding & Student Craft
 - STEM coding: time: 3:45 PM to 4:45 PM Friday
 - Student Craft: time: Morning before school, once a month
 - o Chairs AND volunteers are needed for all of these programs.
 - We are negotiating with vendors to bring high quality programs and caring vendors that will also support PTSA
