


Somerset Families,

This is a hard Somerset Strong News for me to write on this Friday evening. It has been a bittersweet week for me as the principal of this very fine school. I was delighted and thrilled to see our hybrid second grade students return to school this week. They arrived in masks, wearing their backpacks and showing a solid understanding of what it means to socially distance. They arrived at a school that was ready to welcome them with layers of health and safety protocols in place. In their small half day cohorts, they laughed, they drew self-portraits, measured objects around the room and heard their teachers share stories read 6 feet in front of them. All four classrooms were greeted with highly qualified certificated teachers. Our classified staff supported our arrival and dismissal protocols to create a smooth entry and exit. They supervised our playground with small cohorts in four different zones. Our second graders were able to experience the brandnew playground structures installed this summer. When asked what they thought of the new playground, three students screamed with excitement, "It's awesome! I love it!" These were the highlights and joyous moments of my week and they were important moments.

The rest of the week has been challenging for me personally. I know this has been challenging for many of you as well. I wish I had an update to report, but at this time I do not.


To this Somerset Strong community, please know that the school district will provide communication as soon as it is available. I will keep you informed of the changes that impact Somerset.








Hidden Talents

Safety Protocols: We thank you in advance for following these:

- This will be an outside event. Dress for the weather.
- Students may be accompanied by 1 parent only. We ask that students go straight to the picture-taking area near the playground in the back of the school, following physical/social distancing guidelines. Staff will be available to assist students through the line. When your student has taken their picture, we ask that you do not stay on the school grounds/playground.
- All students and staff will be masked at all times—except for the short time that the student removes the mask to take a picture.
- Physical distancing is required.
