Wednesday: Friendship


Thursday: Self-care

- Thursday and Friday prior to start dates are for classroom and teacher preparation. Teachers provide async learning.
- Remote days on Wednesday & Friday follow current Schedule.
- Grade 3-5 drop-off is at 143<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE crosswalk. Use either side of street. Students must use crosswalk
- Drop off is 8:50 and 12:50. Remain in the car until greeted by Somerset staff.
- Please remember to complete health check prior to 8:30 and 12:30 to ensure efficient arrival for student.
