Over the course of the next two weeks, our grade level teachers will be meeting with our Student Support Team to review student data collected over the first quarter to ensure that we are serving the needs of each individual student at Somerset. During the two-hour session, we collaboratively look at student data, identify patterns of unfinished learning, and strategize intentional focus for intervention or

extension. It is possible that your child's teacher may need to adjust their small group meetings on their scheduled day in order to make time for this important work. In the past, teachers were released from teaching for a half day and substitute teacher would cover the classroom. This year we have condensed the time and are using the asynchronous afternoons for many of these sessions.

Please note that starting on Wednesday, November 18, elementary students will now have <u>up to 90</u> minutes of Wednesdays for learning time available for synchronous instructional time, with the remainder staying as asynchronous time. Your child's teacher will communicate any changes to their schedules with you.





This weekend many Indians in our community and around the world will celebrate one of the most important Hindu festivals known as Diwali. This five-day festival is often called "the festival of lights" and is considered to be the start of the new year for those celebrating. This holiday symbolizes the spiritual victory of light over darkness and good over evil.
