#### **RETURN To K-2 IN-PERSON LEARNING**

We are busy preparing for the return to in person learning for our K-2 families. On Thursday, I held a Parent Principal Connect for k-2 parents returning to in person learning. I want to highlight the importance of completing the Attestation Form- Health Check prior to your child's arrival each day so they can go straight to class upon entering the building. K-1 parents who have selected the in-person learning model should be receiving am/pm assignment by middle of next week. Second grade students should have already received an email with this information. Transportation Department will notify families with bus routes information to the students who qualify for bus services.

### **SPECIALIST SCHEDULE**

Somerset's school day is 9:05-3:35. Some of the day has been designated as asynchronous, but it is still part of our state mandated required school time. All specialist classes have been scheduled within the school day and attendance is required as part of the elementary school day. Extracurricular activities and private lessons should be scheduled outside of school hours.

I am excited to have some of our Superstars back in the building this month and look forward to the day when we are able to return as one big *In Person* school community. I am working with our school nurse, custodial staff and educators to prepare the building with all of the health and safety measures to mitigate the spread of Covid 19 for our returning students. It is this collaboration that make us Somerset Strong.


