

#### **BSD Receives Childcare Grants**

The Bellevue School District recently received two grants to support childcare offered by the district. The King County COVID-19 Childcare Provider Supports Grant and the Non-Profit Relief Grant from the City of the Bellevue provide funds to support childcare operations. The grant funds will be used to support the continued operation of childcare for area families.

The King County COVID-19 Childcare Provider Supports Grants were available to any licensed provider in King County serving children age 0 to 12 and are funded by private donation and public dollars, both federal and local. Grant funds provided to childcare providers in King County came from King County CARES Act funds. Grant funds from the City of Bellevue originated from the CARES Act and the Coronavirus Relief Fund, administered by the Washington State Department of Commerce.
