Location: Somerset Elementary School (under the covered basketball area outside, in the back of the school)

Safety Protocols: We thank you in advance for following these:

- This will be an outside event.
- Dress for the weather. Students may be accompanied by 1 parent only.
- Staff will be available to assist students through the line. We ask that students go straight to the picture-taking area near the playground in the back of the school, following physical/social distancing guidelines.
- When your student has taken their picture, we ask that you do not stay on the school grounds/playground.
- All students and staff will be masked at all times—except for the short time that the student removes the mask to take a picture.
- Physical distancing is required.

Please note that students are not required to attend/participate. For any families that do not feel comfortable participating, we will follow up with alternative options for submitting your student's picture for the yearbook.



These events are designed for families starting high school next school year.



# **Back to Buildings Update**


Bellevue School District is bringing back our youngest learners, starting Jan. 21, 2021. We know there are a lot of questions about our return to in-person learning, and we have a detailed plan for bringing students back, as public health conditions allow.

Thursday, January 21, 2021: 2nd grade Monday, January 25, 2021: 1st grade Monday, February 1, 2021: Kindergarten There is a detailed FAQ.

We are currently in <u>Stage 2</u>: <u>Remote Learning</u>. We will be in Stage 3 when K-2 students start later this month. As of January 9, there are <u>352 positive COVID-19 cases per 100,000 people in King County in the past 14 days</u>.


