## Summer Meal Kits Available Thursdays, Beginning July 1

To provide continued food support for children in our community, Nutrition Services will offer families a five-day meal kit to be picked up one day per week throughout the summer. The kit will contain five breakfast entrees, five lunch entrees, fruits, vegetables and milk for each child.

To ensure that enough kits are prepared each week, meal kits will be available through a pre-order system. The pre-order form will open at 8 p.m. Thursday, June 24, and close at 8 a.m. Monday, June 28 for the July 1 pick up. For future weeks, the pre-order form will follow the same pattern of opening at 8 p.m. on Thursday, and closing at 8 a.m. on Monday for that Thursday' pick up. The pre-order form can be found on the Meals2Go webpage beginning June 22. More information will be posted on the Meals2Go webpage.

#### **Student Technology Device**

For the first time since implementing 1:1 in the district, all K-12 students will be able to keep their devices over the summer. This ensures every student has an opportunity to continue to learn, connect, innovate, communicate, collaborate and so much more.

Students leaving BSD need to turn in their laptop or iPad on or before their last day of school. They can give it to their classroom teacher or use the window at the office to drop off. 1st graders will bring their iPad in the fall and trade it in for a laptop. 5th graders will also exchange their elementary laptop in the fall for their 6th grade laptop.

BSD will be operating a Student Tech Center during the summer. Students will be able to visit the Tech Center and get support. Location and hours are still to be determined.

# **BSD Summer Programs**

#### **Elementary Literacy & Math**

Our elementary program is an invitation-only program, providing curriculum review and support for students determined to need extended instruction in either Literacy (targeting grades 3-4) or Math (targeting grade 4-5). Each session will include 25 minutes of direct instruction (1:1 or small group settings), and student well-being activities with community partners and educators. When registering, parents & guardians will have the option of enrolling their student for either entirely in-person learning at the school *or* entirely virtual instruction. These learning models are not interchangeable, and students will stay in that model for duration of program.

• Dates: July 6-30, 2021, Monday – Friday (program starts on a Tuesday)

- Hours: Session #1 9:00-10:30am, Session #2 10:30am-Noon
- Learning Model: Students will enroll in an entirely In-Person or an entirely Virtual learning model
- Courses: Literacy or Math
- Location for In-Person: Stevenson Elementary 14220 NE 8th St, Bellevue, WA 98007
- Tuition: There is no charge for students invited to register for this program
- Transportation: Upon request, District Yellow Bus service will be available for modified summer routes
- Food: There is no food service to be provided for this program

Pfizer first or second shots available for **children 12 and older** are available at Bellevue Fire pop-up clinics, along with Moderna and J&J vaccines for adults.


