

## **After School Activity Information**

Following up on our last week's information about after school programs we wanted to highlight that the **after-school programs in the Community News** section are run by outside vendors and are NOT sponsored by the PTSA. As a service to the community, the PTSA publicizes these programs in the eNews. In addition to these outside vendor-run programs, Somerset Elementary School will run some clubs after school. This school year there are two types of after-school activities:

- 1. Those run by our PTSA: **Chess Club and Math Circle**. These clubs are heavily dependent on parent volunteers and PTSA membership is required to register. These activities will be announced in the PTSA News section.
- 2. Those run by outside vendors: **Debate and Drama**. All registrations and payments are handled by the vendor directly. They are not covered by our insurance. These after school activities will run virtual for the foreseeable future.

**Somerset Chess Club Registration** 

Chess is excellent at teaching kids mental discipline, to look at all their options, to compete under time pressure, to play fair, to learn that mistakes have consequences, to not give up when behind, and to learn many more important life lessons.

Somerset's Chess Club has consistently performed well in state tournaments, this year tying for first place in Washington State! Students in grades K through 5 are invited to join the online club, conducted by returning Coaches Brad and Tim.

On Mondays, Session I with Coach Brad will be a Beginner class, and Session II with Coach Tim will be an Advanced class. On Tuesdays, Session I and II will both be for Intermediate players.

All sessions are scheduled from 3:30pm to 5:00pm. Depending on demand, a third session may be added at 5:10pm to accommodate the overflow.

The tuition rate is \$320 (reduced due to online format), which includes: 25 chess club sessions and a Gold membership for the ChessKid website. PTSA membership is required for registration.

Registered students will be divided into Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced classes by the coaches. If your child is not an absolute beginner, the coaches are happy to do a short 1:1 video call with parents to assess ability before enrollment, they can be contacted directly at the <u>theallaboutschool@gmail.com</u>.

# Principal Birthday Lunches





### Update on Transition to Hybrid

At the September 15 School Board meeting, the Bellevue School District shared <u>a</u> draft road map for our transition to Hybrid Learning. Once we see a consistent downward trend in infection rates, we will bring students back in gradual waves for in-person instruction. Our top priorities for the start of in-person learning include getting our health protocols right, minimizing learning loss and delays, and supporting students both academically and emotionally. Starting September 21st, we are serving some students receiving special education services, multi-language learners and students who received an incomplete last spring in our buildings. As we move forward, we plan to increase the in-person services to the before mentioned groups as well as welcome additional students back in person as follows:

- 1. Pre-K 2nd grade for 5 days per week
- 2.  $3^{rd} 5^{th}$  grade students for 2-3 days per week

- 3. Middle and high school  $(6^{th} 12^{th} \text{ grades})$  for 1 day per week
- 4. Middle and high school moving to 2-3 days per week
